### \*EXPLANATION OF FEES & LEVIES (Applied each Term)

#### SCHOOL FEES

These fees are calculated based on the recommendations of Brisbane Catholic Education. Senior Levy is an additional \$160 for Year 11/12 students.

#### CAPITAL LEVY

This is a compulsory levy charged per family.  
It is used to meet current and future commitments for building projects.

This levy is NOT tax deductible

#### P&F LEVY

This levy is collected on behalf of the Mt Maria College P&F Association. The funds are used to complete projects at the discretion of the P&F Committee.

#### RESOURCE & ACTIVITY LEVY

Mt Maria College Petrie provides on levy combining subject levies, excursions and year end activities for each year level. Camps for years 7, 8, 10, 11 & 12 are additional.

#### ICT LEVY

This levy is for all technology requirements of the College.

#### LAPTOP LEVY

This levy relates to the 1:1 laptop purchase for students in Years 7,9,10 and 11.
