Industry Recruit

for the Pathway to Industry

Prepare for a trade of industry career as an Industry Recruit in Year 10. Develop independent learning and organisation skills to be successful in your pathway to employment in trades and industry. Explore electives for your Senior pathway, including Vocational Education & Training (VET) experiences such as Trade Taster or an early start on a school-based traineeship or apprenticeship. 


